Introduction

We, at Shoobridge Funeral Services, pride ourselves on our clear, transparent and honest approach to pricing. As such, we have designed fully inclusive funeral packages in addition to our bespoke price options.

Due to the vast range of options available to you today, determining the complete cost of a funeral service is difficult and many funeral directors will indicate a cost PLUS disbursements. Disbursements are monies paid by funeral directors to third parties on behalf of the client. These might include payments to doctors, church ministers, cemeteries or crematoria and newspapers. However, 'we,' have included all of the necessary items and the cost of these in order to carry out the complete service and give our clients and potential clients, the overall, inclusive cost of the funeral.

There are of course, additional items such as: funeral notices placed in local or national newspapers, obituaries and floral tributes - these will incur further charges. An alternative coffin selection, if required, can also be accommodated for an additional fee. Charges are dependent upon individual requirements and selections.

Included in every Funeral Service:

- Home visits for discussing funeral arrangements, if required
- Basic hygienic treatment of the deceased and preparation for Chapel of Rest visits
- Provision of a suitable garment or gown if personal clothing is not provided
- Facilitating Chapel of Rest visits during office hours
- Option to compile and place funeral notices such as obituaries, acknowledgements and attendance 'Thanks Notice' in local and national newspapers
- Liaising with florists and arranging family floral tributes
- Transporting floral tributes to a local destination following the funeral service
- Administration of all charity donations 'in lieu of flowers'
- Online, dedicated, personable tribute page
- Collection locally and temporary storage of cremated remains

The funeral services we offer are fully bespoke. This allows the client the freedom to make choices in order to make the funeral unique and personal in a way that befits the deceased.



The Direct Cremation Service was initially constructed to accommodate families wishing to hold a 'Thanksgiving' or 'Memorial Service' as their primary focus after the event of the actual cremation of their loved one.

(The Direct Cremation Service does not include any service held in the crematorium grounds or chapel. No attendance by family, friends or mourners is permitted)

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral
- Assistance with the completion of all necessary paperwork and documentation
- Liaising with third parties and statutory bodies such as: doctors, hospital administrators, medical and crematoria staff
- Paying all necessary fees and expenses, in advance, on behalf of the client – see below
- The conveyance/transportation of the deceased into our care from the place of death, locally – within a 20 mile radius - during office hours
- Practical, respectful and dignified treatment of the deceased whilst in our care
- The provision of a traditional, oak veneered cremation coffin, fully fitted, lined and including an engraved nameplate
- The conveyance of the deceased, by hearsette, directly to The Exeter & Devon Crematorium on the day of the funeral
- The services of the funeral director and necessary staff to effect the funeral on the day
- The choice of day for the cremation (subject to availability)

(The doctor's fees for completion of official cremation forms, crematorium fees and fixed charges including environmental surcharges, will be paid on behalf of the client.)

Full payment for The Direct Cremation Service is required prior to the funeral.



The Early Cremation Service

The Early Cremation Service, complies with SAIF's (The National Society of Allied and Independent Funeral Directors) and the NAFD's (National Association of Funeral Directors) Codes of Conduct regarding the provision of a simple or basic funeral service which is both dignified and affordable.

(Available for services held Monday – Friday before 10:00 a.m. at the East Devon Crematorium, near Whimble and the Exeter and Devon Crematorium ONLY. Please contact us for more information regarding this option)

The Early Cremation Service is fully inclusive of ALL the funeral director's charges AND the disbursements (statutory fees) necessary to undertake the funeral.

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- All items and services listed in the 'Introduction' section of this brochure
- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral and liaising with third parties and statutory bodies such as; hospitals, church ministers/celebrants, doctors, medical staff, cemeteries or crematoria staff
- Transportation of the deceased into our care locally within a 20-mile radius, during office hours
- Care of the deceased prior to the funeral including basic hygienic treatment
- Provision of an oak veneered, fully upholstered, coffin suitable for cremation
- Conveyance of the deceased by traditional hearse directly to the East Devon Crematorium, Strete Raleigh, Whimble at the specified time
- The services of the funeral director and all necessary staff to carry out the funeral on the allotted day
- The choice of day and time, with the service held no later than 9.30 a.m. Monday – Friday as far as possible and, as available
- Crematorium fees and charges including environmental surcharges will be paid on your behalf and are included in this package
- Statutory medical fees – relating to the production of official cremation forms – will be paid on behalf of the client and are included in this package
- A celebrant or church minister to lead the funeral service on the day. This could be a member of the local clergy, an independent funeral celebrant or a member of the British Humanist Association (BHA - strictly atheist)

Additional items, not included, that you may wish to consider are, the provision of:

- Saloon cars and/or limousines for transporting the immediate family and/or close friends
 - Printed 'Orders of Service' - including the insertion of family photographs
 - Visual tributes, including photos and video, recording and casting options

 - Family floral tributes - "We work closely with local florists ensuring the best quality".
 - An alternative choice of coffin, such as: willow, solid wood, cardboard, picture coffins, etc.
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The Cremation Service

Includes all local crematoria: Exeter & Devon, East Devon (Whimble), Taunton, Yeovil and Torquay.

All of our funeral services are fully bespoke, allowing you the freedom to choose whatever you want, in order to make the funeral special, personal, in whichever way you would like.

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- All items and services listed in the 'Introduction' section of this brochure
- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral and liaising with third parties and statutory bodies such as; hospitals, church ministers/celebrants, doctors, medical staff, cemeteries or crematoria staff
- Paying all necessary fees and expenses, in advance, on behalf of the client (these include some or all of the following:
Cremation and crematorium fees, fixed charges, environmental surcharges, Doctor's fees for completion of official Cremation Forms, Payments to celebrants or ministers conducting the funeral service
- The conveyance/transportation of the deceased into our care from the place of death, locally
- Practical, respectful and dignified treatment of the deceased whilst in our care
- The provision of a traditional, oak veneered cremation coffin, fully fitted, lined and upholstered including an engraved nameplate (other choices, selections and options are available on request)
- The conveyance of the deceased, by hearse, to a local crematorium on the day of the funeral
- The services of the funeral director and necessary staff to effect the funeral on the day
- The choice of day and time for the funeral (subject to availability) at a local crematorium such as: Exeter and Devon, East Devon - Whimble, Taunton Deane, Torbay and District or Yeovil
- The cremation fees and fixed charges, including environmental surcharges, will be paid on behalf of the client
- The doctor's fees for completion of official Cremation Forms will be paid on behalf of the client prior to the funeral
- A funeral celebrant, church minister, officiant, or a member of the British Humanist Association, will visit the family prior to the funeral, prepare a tribute and lead the funeral service on the day

Additional items, not included, that you may wish to consider are, the provision of:

- Saloon cars and/or limousines for transporting the immediate family and/or close friends
- Printed 'Orders of Service' - including the insertion of family photographs
- Visual tributes, including photos and video, recording and casting options

The crematorium will contact you regarding Memorial options such as marker stones, rose bushes for placement in the Garden of Remembrance or an entry in the 'Book of Remembrance'.



The Churchyard Burial Service

Churches in England and Wales have rules nationally and also, locally. Variations exist as to the allowable monuments within these churchyards and annexes. The local P.C.C. – Parochial Church Council, is likely to write to you after the funeral has taken place. Generally, memorials are not placed on graves for a six-month period but the memorial can be ordered in readiness. Shoobridge Funeral Services will be happy to help you with all local memorial matters.

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- All items and services listed in the 'Introduction' section of this brochure
- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral, assistance with the completion of all necessary paperwork, liaising with all third parties and statutory bodies such as: doctors; hospital and medial staff; administrators; and burial site / cemetery staff and representatives
- Paying all necessary fees, disbursements and expenses, in advance, on behalf of the client
- Conveyance/transportation of the deceased into our care from the place of death, locally
- Care of the deceased prior to and up to the day of the funeral, including sanitization
- Provision of a traditional, oak veneered burial coffin, fully fitted, lined and upholstered, including engraved nameplate
- Conveyance of the deceased by hearse from any local address to the church for the service, if applicable and onto the churchyard for the interment on the same day
- The services of the funeral director and necessary staff to effect the funeral on the day
- The choice of day and time for the funeral service (subject to availability) at any local, parish church – others within Devon, Somerset, Dorset or Nationally may attract additional travelling costs
- PCC, Church, Churchyard fees and charges, including Organist and Verger
- Clergy, Minister, PCC, Administration and travelling fees for taking the service – as applicable
- Gravedigger, grave preparation fees and grave marker (for identification purposes)
- Monumental mason fees for removal of existing memorials if applicable

Additional items, not included, that you may wish to consider are, the provision of:

- Saloon cars and/or limousines for transporting the immediate family and/or close friends
 - Printed 'Orders of Service' - including the insertion of family photographs
 - Visual tributes, including photos and video, recording and casting options

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The Cemetery Burial Service

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- All items and services listed in the 'Introduction' section of this brochure
- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral
- Assisting with the completion of all required paperwork and documentation, liaising with third parties and statutory bodies including; hospital administrators, medical staff and local authorities
- Payment of all necessary fees and expenses, in advance, on behalf of the client
(These include some or all of the following fees when the funeral service is held in a church locally: church, heating, organist and vergers)
- Interment fees – Single Plot/Adult Grave (see 'Exclusive Rights' and 'Grant to Erect a Memorial' notes below)
- Gravedigger, grave preparation fees and supply of a grave marker (for identification purposes)
- The conveyance/transportation of the deceased into our care from the place of death, locally
- Practical, respectful and dignified care of the deceased
- The provision of a traditional, oak veneered burial coffin, fully fitted, lined and upholstered including an engraved nameplate (alternative options / selections are available)
- Conveyance of the deceased by hearse to the chosen, local funeral service venue and onto the cemetery for the interment on the same day
- The services of the funeral director and necessary staff to effect the funeral on the day
- The choice of day and time for the funeral service (subject to availability) followed by burial at any local (East Devon) parish cemetery, Higher Cemetery, Exwick Cemetery or Topsham Cemetery. (Other cemeteries within Devon, Somerset, Dorset or nationally - may attract additional travelling costs and non-residential surcharges)
- Monumental Mason fees for removal of existing memorials (if applicable)
- A church minister, funeral celebrant, officiant or a member of the British Humanist Association, will visit the family prior to the funeral, prepare a tribute and lead the funeral service on the day

Additional items, not included, that you may wish to consider are, the provision of:

- Saloon cars and/or limousines for transporting the immediate family and/or close friends
- Printed 'Orders of Service' - including the insertion of family photographs
- Visual tributes, including photos and video, recording and casting options
- Funeral notices, 'Thanks' notices and obituaries - placed in local and national newspapers
- Family floral tributes - "We work closely with local florists ensuring the best quality".

N.B Exclusive Rights and Grant to Erect a Memorial

Cemeteries in England and Wales have different local and national rules. Some variables exist regarding allowable 'memorial' monuments within these cemeteries and some cemeteries have designated areas for different religions or denominations – your funeral director will advise you accordingly. In addition, the placement of grave memorials is not usually allowed for six months although the memorial can be ordered in readiness. Shoobridge Funeral Services will be happy to help you regarding all local memorial matters.



The Woodland Burial Service

The Details: 'What You Will Receive'

- All items and services listed in the 'Introduction' section of this brochure
- The services of the funeral director in arranging the funeral, assistance with completion of all the necessary paperwork, liaising with all third parties and statutory bodies such as: doctors; hospital and medical staff; administrators; burial site / cemetery staff and representatives all necessary fees, disbursements and expenses, in advance, on behalf of the client
- Conveyance/transportation of the deceased into 'our' care from the place of death, locally
- Care of the deceased prior to and up to, the day of the funeral, including sanitization
- Provision of a traditional oak veneered burial coffin, fully fitted, lined and upholstered, including engraved nameplate
- Conveyance of the deceased by hearse from a local address to the burial site for the full service on the day of the funeral
- The services of the funeral director and necessary staff to effect the funeral on the day
- The choice of day and time for the funeral service (subject to availability)
- Interment fees – Single, Double, Side-by-side (reserved) - as applicable
- Gravedigger and grave preparation fees
- A graveside service or a service held in a local venue – some venues may incur an additional charge, please request more details
- A funeral officiant or church minister to visit the family prior to the funeral; to prepare a tribute and to lead the funeral service on the day. This could be a member of the local clergy, an independent funeral celebrant or a member of the BHA – British Humanist Association (Atheist)

Additional items, not included, that you may wish to consider are, the providing of:

- Saloon cars and/or limousines for transporting the immediate family and/or close friends
- Printed 'Orders of Service' - including the insertion of family photographs
- Visual tributes, including photos and video, recording and casting options
- Funeral notices, 'Thanks' notices and obituaries - placed in local and national newspapers
- Family floral tributes - "We work closely with local florists ensuring the best quality".
- An alternative choice of coffin, such as: willow, solid wood, cardboard, picture coffins, etc.

There are a number of options to consider, primarily, the location of the burial. For the purpose of this 'package,' we have included - Great Bradley Cottage, nr. Tiverton, 'Woodland Burial Site'. However, there are a number of other options available locally and these include: Seaton, Exwick Cemetery, Cheriton Bishop, Cockington, Torquay, Oakhampton, Totnes and Yealmpton.

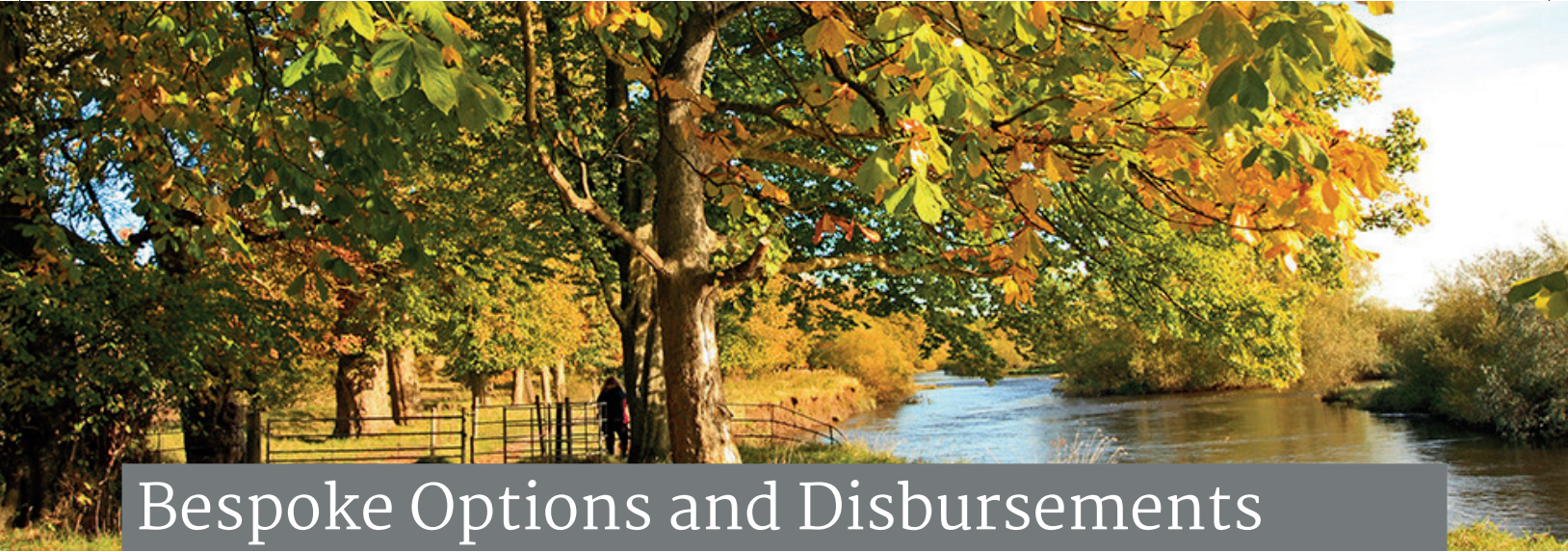

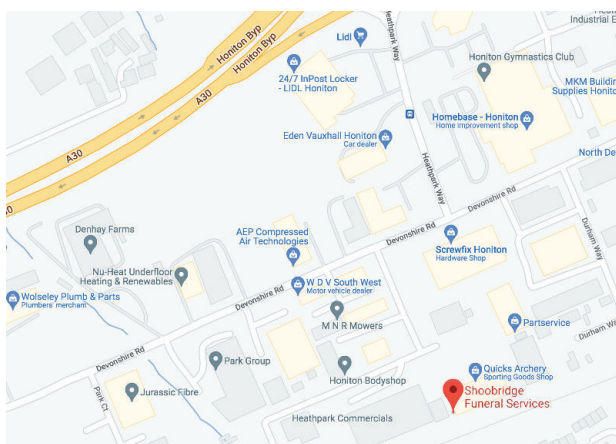

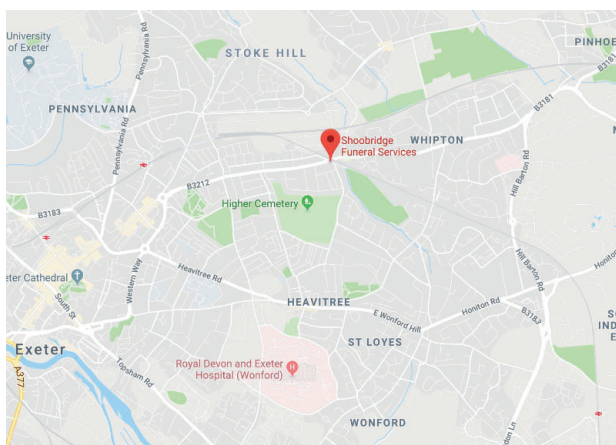
